Guidelines for Recreational Fires

Approved by Council July 11, 2005
Resolution Number 2005-001

The size of the fire must be limited to a 3-foot diameter and must be at least 25 feet from any building or combustible structure such as but not limited to decks, fences and/or fuel tanks.

Only wood may be burned, with a minimum of 1-inch diameter. No brush, yard waste, or treated wood may be burned.

No rubbish can be burned at any time.

A responsible adult must be present at all times.

The fire must be located on your own property. If the fire is in an easement area, you must have approval from all involved parties.

Fires are not allowed if winds are in excess of 15 miles per hour.

Hours for recreational fires are limited to 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m. (midnight)

Any police or fire officer may withdraw permission for the fire due to climatic conditions, extreme dryness, nuisance problems, or violations of these guidelines.

A current copy of these guidelines serves as your permit and must be on site. Copies of this policy are available at the City Clerk's Office.
